

## MINUTES OF THE MEETING

**The meeting was held by video conference on 27 June 2018**

Based on the Work Program for Scientific and Technological Cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia (MoESS) and the Ministry of Science and Technology of the State of Israel, signed in Tel Aviv on 6 June 2017, Protocol of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Joint Slovenian – Israeli Committee on Scientific and Technological Cooperation, signed in Tel Aviv on 6 June 2017 and on the Call for proposals for scientific cooperation between the Republic of Slovenia and the State of Israel, announced by the Slovenian Research Agency (ARRS) and Ministry of Science and Technology of the State of Israel (MOST), announced respectively in November 2017, the two sides recognize:

ARRS and MOST received 13 proposals for research projects for the first topic: "Innovative water management and monitoring technologies (including remote sensing)";

ARRS and MOST received 10 proposals for research projects for the second topic: "Digital aspects of research in social science and humanities".

The submitted project proposals have been peer-reviewed by both sides by external reviewers. The Israeli side was responsible for evaluation of the first topic and the Slovenian side was responsible for evaluation of the second topic.

MoESS and MOST have come to the agreement to co-finance 4 of the submitted projects, 2 from each priority field.

The approved projects and amount of financial support are listed in Annex 1.


Both sides agreed to the following time-table:

- The results of the joint call for proposals for the period 2018 – 2020 - announcement letters will be sent by both sides on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2018;
- Start of the approved projects – 13<sup>th</sup> September 2018, duration until 12<sup>th</sup> September 2020;
- Joint interim and final reports will be prepared by the research groups and shall be sent to ARRS and MOST in accordance with national rules.
