

PROTOCOL
amending the Protocol of the Joint Committee Meeting
of the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia and
the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey in Ljubljana, 8 May 2019


Based on the Agreement on Co-operation in Science and Technology between the Government of the Republic of Slovenia and the Government of the Republic of Turkey signed in Ljubljana on April 19, 2001 and on the call for proposals for joint research projects, announced by the Slovenian Research Agency (ARRS) and the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TÜBİTAK) respectively in 2014, the two sides signed the Protocol of the Joint Committee Meeting of the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia and the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey, held in Ljubljana 8 May 2019, and signed by correspondence in Ljubljana on 15 May 2019 and in Ankara on 16 May 2019.

Both parties agree that the third paragraph of item 4 of the Protocol should be amended to read as follows:

The parties agreed as well that priority will be given to project proposals submitted by project leaders that haven't received funding in the last three joint calls for proposals, namely for the periods 2017–2019, 2018–2021, 2019–2022.
