DECISION DOCUMENT on co-funding Slovenian – Japanese joint projects in FY 2020 (April 1, 2020 – March 31, 2022)

Based on Memorandum of Understanding on Scientific Cooperation between the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Slovenia (MESS) and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) signed in April 2001 and on the Call for proposals for joint research projects, published by the Slovenian Research Agency and the JSPS, respectively in 2019, the two sides realize that:

27 (twenty seven) proposals for joint research projects were submitted on both sides.

Through the comparison of peer review screening results concluded respectively and the following discussion by the email correspondences between MESS and JSPS, they decided to jointly fund the following 4 (four) research projects in FY 2020 in the period from April 1, 2020 until March, 31 2022.
